

Workers' union to protest

The Karnataka Workers' Union has blamed the State Government of succumbing to pressure of industrialists and not implementing the revised minimum wages for workers, despite recommendation from the Labour Department.

The union said that over one crore workers in the industrial and unorganised sector in the State were unable to lead a life due to inflation. The members will stage a protest in front of Town Hall here on Wednesday demanding higher minimum wages.

General secretary of the union E.K.N. Rajan told presspersons that the Labour Department had sent a proposal to the State government to fix minimum wages at Rs. 10,500.
