Mobile app for Tripura govt employees

gartala: The accountant general of Tripura has commissioned a mobile app called 'mGPF' for GPF subscribers of the state government to provide access to their monthly credit and debits of GPF for the last three years.

By launching this service, which will be replicated in all other AG offices across the country soon, Tripura has become a pioneer in this sector, said Tripura chief secretary Y P Singh, who launched the app on Friday.

The app will run on any Smartphone having Android Version 4.2 and above and will facilitate state government employees in accessing his or her GPF account anytime, anywhere on their smart phones.

Other GPF-related information like eligibility to join GPF, rates and other conditions can also be browsed, said Singh.

He added that the app has been developed jointly by AG Tripura and National Informatics Centre, Agartala. For security reasons, individual PIN have been allotted to all GPF subscribers to surf their GPF accounts online using the app. tnn
