ORDER :

In the G.Os. first and second read above, orders were issued regard-
ing payment of subsistence allowance at the rate of Rs. 200/- to each
freed bonded labourer at the time of release.

2. As the present quantum of subsistence allowance is considered
to be inadequate, Government hereby enhance the rate of subsistence
allowance from Rs. 200 to Rs. 500 to each of the released bonded
labourers.

3. An amount of Rs. 200 will be debited to,--

"288 Social Security and Welfare--C. Welfare of Scheduled
Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes--
M.H. 05--Welfare of Scheduled Castes--F. Other Social
Welfare Schemes Monetary Relief and legal aid to victims
of atrocities on Scheduled Castes--090--Grants--in-Aid.

4. The additional amount of Rs. 300 per bonded labourer shall
be met from the grants released from the State share for rehabilitation
of bonded labourers under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme under
the following head of account :

Support Schemes."

5. The total amount of Rs. 500 should be paid immediately after the release of the bonded labourer, without any delay so that he is able to subsist until further rehabilitation measures are implemented.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance and Planning (Fin. Wing) Department vide their U.O. No. 5523/FS/84, dated 20-12-84.
