In the G. O. first cited, orders have been issued constituting the State Level Committee with the following members to consider the rehabilitation proposals sent by the District Collectors and approve the Schemes :

In the reference second cited, Government of India have suggested the delegation of powers to the District Collectors to sanction rehabilitation assistance, and have suggested that the State Level Committee be responsible for the monitoring and review of the programme. The State Government have accepted this suggestion and issued orders in the reference third cited delegating powers of sanction to the District Collectors and have also constituted the District Level Screening Committees.

3. Accordingly Government now direct that the State Level Committee Constituted in G. O. first cited shall, hereafter, review the progress of the schemes of rehabilitation both in physical and financial terms under the Centrally Sponsored Programmes. It shall meet at least twice in a year for the purpose and issue suitable directions and guidelines regarding the implementation of the programme.
