

GIST OF DISCUSSIONS HELD ON 12-6-2000 ON FORMATION OF COOPERATIVE SOCIETIES OF BONDED LABOURERS IN MAHABUBNAGAR DISTRICT.

Visited Office of Deputy Director (SW), held discussions with Deputy Director and Divisional Cooperative Officers on formation of Co-operative Societies of Bonded labourers in the district. So far only two Societies have been formed. Sri T. Anjaiah, Divisional Cooperative Officer, Mahabubnagar informed that he had received request for formation of another Society today only i.e. 12-6-2000. Deputy Director informed that he had kept applications ready for formation of another 10 Societies. Only for want of adequate number of forms these Societies have not been formed as yet. Deputy Director informed that he had already placed order for printing of adequate number of forms. The Divisional Cooperative Officer informed that it would take only a day to register all the Societies. Dy. Director also informed that he would form 60 Cooperatives Societies of bonded labourers. He had already finalized lists for 34 societies. In these 34 Societies, 850 bonded labourers will be made members. The issue was also discussed with the Collector in detail. Collector had already taken all the possible steps for registration of all the Societies and assured that the entire exercise will be completed by 17-6-2000. He also assured that wage Employment works on contract basis will be entrusted to some of these societies for their gainful employment.

Following documents are required for registration of any society:

- i) Payment of registration fees at Rs.11/- per member. In total Rs.165/- is required for registration of any society of 15 members.
- ii) List of members together with their signatures in 6 copies.
- iii) Form A R3(1) in 6 copies.
- iv) Declarations by members to be given in 6 copies.
- v) Resolution of the society to be furnished in 6 copies.
- vi) Bye law of the society to be furnished in 6 copies.

During discussion I have also informed Collector that National Human Rights Commission as was originally scheduled might visit the district any time in the first week of July, 2000. Collector requested that the Committee may kindly visit in the second week of July, 2000. Dy. Director informed that the following Societies will be formed in the district and the officers have been directed by the Collector to take immediate necessary action in collaboration with ASWOs.

- i) Mahabubnagar : Sri T. Anjaiah, DLC to assist to form 9 Cooperative Societies.

- ii) Wanaparthy: Sri Ramakrishna Prasad, DLCO -8 Societies.
- iii) Nagarkurnool: Mohd. Yusuf, DLCO -6 Societies
