Sir,

I am directed to forward herewith a photo-copy of letter dated 06-03-2002 from Mrs. S. Jais Joint Secretary, National Human Rights Commission Sardar Patel Bhawan, Sansad Marg, New Delhi.

In this letter, it is stated that to expand the area of monitoring and evolve a suitable mechanism to constantly review the implementation of the provisions of the Bonded Labour Act, the Commission has decided to have quarterly reports on the status of bonded labour in the prescribed proforma from state governments and has asked for this report by 15th March, 2002.

As per sections 10 to 14 of this Act, implementation of the provisions of this Act is to be done by the District Magistrate and the Officer authorised by the District Magistrate. Notification dated 27-2-1997 conferring the powers under Section of the Bonded Labour Act to perform all such duties as are necessary to ensure that provisions of the said Act are properly carried out in Govt. of NCT of Delhi <sup>was issued</sup> (copy enclosed).

Further, the Vigilance Committee at District and Sub Division levels are functioning directly under the control and supervision of
