60 child labourers rescued in Jaipur

The police have rescued over 60 child labourers, forced into the bangle making and other works, in the Walled City and other parts of Jaipur and arrested half-a-dozen persons on charges of child trafficking.

Deputy Commissioner of Police (Jaipur North) Anshuman Bhomia said 53 children were rescued from a bangle factory at Kalyanji Ka Rasta in the Walled City after some Child Line activists got a tip-off and informed the police.

The factory owner and three others were arrested.
