LABOUR RIGHTS ARE HUMAN RIGHTS AT WORKPLACE

THE FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS OF LABOUR

- RIGHT TO FORM UNIONS
- RIGHT TO BARGAIN COLLECTIVELY
- RIGHT TO BE FREE FROM FORCED LABOUR/ BONDED LABOUR
- RIGHT NOT TO EMPLOY CHILDREN
- RIGHT TO HAVE EQUAL PAY FOR EQUAL WORK
- RIGHT TO HAVE A HEALTHY AND SAFE WORKPLACE
- RIGHT TO HAVE NEED-BASED MINIMUM WAGE

These rights are backed by The Constitution of India as well the Laws of the country.
