

S. O. 306, dated 2nd March, 1981, published in Bihar Gazette Part II, dated March 4, 1981.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 21 of the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976 (No. 19 of 1976), and in partial modification of Labour and Employment Department Notification S. O. 862 dated the 10th May, 1976, so far as it relates to whole of Nawadah sub-division the Governor of Bihar is pleased to confer on Shri Shaligram Mishra, Executive Magistrate of first class for whole of the Nawadah district for the trial of offences under the said Act and to direct that on such conferment of powers, the said Executive Magistrate on whom the powers have been so conferred, shall be deemed for the purposes of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), to be a Judicial Magistrate of the first class for the purposes of the said Act.
